


OUR PRESENCE

ABOUT THE ROLE

JOB PROFILE

To provide hands-on wardrobe support to ensure performers are dressed safely and on time. Sleeping Beauty is Beacon Arts Centre's Christmas pantomime with a cast of 7 principle, 4 ensemble, and a 3-piece band. It's a lively, music-heavy show with quick changes and multiple costume looks.

MAIN DUTIES

Laundry and costume Care

- Run daily laundry (washing, drying, stain treatment, pressing/steaming) per show schedules and fabric care labels
- Track garment rotations and drying times; maintain a tidy, well-ventilated laundry area
- · Carry out minor repairs (buttons, hems, poppers, zips) and escalate larger fixes promptly

Show running and quick changes

- Prep dressing rooms, presets, and costume plots; lay out costumes and accessories
- Execute and support quick changes safely and efficiently; reset after each show


Rehearsals, tech & dress

- Attend technical/dress sessions from Tuesday 2 December onward
- Update and maintain costume tracks/plots and note any changes from the creative team
- Support notes calls and implement adjustments between shows

Health & Safety / Admin

- Follow Beacon Arts Centre's Health and Safety procedures (PAT test appliances, safe use of steamers/irons, manual handling)
- Keep wardrobe spaces orderly; manage consumables (detergent, lint rollers, sewing kit).


ESSENTIAL KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND EXPERIENCE
